1426.01 ADOPTION BY REFERENCE.

The National Electrical Code, 1999 edition, as published by the National Fire Protection Association, is hereby adopted as the official Electrical Code of the City for establishing minimum legal requirements for the installation, maintenance, inspection and reinspection of electrical equipment in the City as therein provided. Each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of the National Electrical Code are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part of this chapter by reference as if fully set out in this chapter, save and except such portions as may be hereinafter amended or repealed.

1426.02 ENFORCING AGENCY.

The County Building Department is hereby authorized and directed to administer and enforce the National Electrical Code within the corporate limits of the City, and the County Building Official is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the City under Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.
